PSAP Script

1. Is the patient awake?

Yes: Respond as usual (see appropriate chief complaint)

No: Go to Step 2

Unsure:Try to wake them up while I wait on the line

2. Is the patient breathing normally?

Unknown: Go to Step 3

Yes:Respond as usual (see appropriate chief complaint)

No: Dispatch ALS/BLS; Transfer to EMS Communicator; Go to Step 4

- 3. Describe the patient's breathing, what does their breathing sound like? How often do you see them breath?
 - If breathing is absent or reported as one of the following agdescriptors:
 - Gasping
 - Once in a while
 - Snoring now anthen
 - Gurgling
 - Barelybreathing
 - Moaning—weak orheavy
 - Occasional

Dispatch ALS/BLS; Transfer to EaviS Communicator

- If breathing normally: respond as usual (see appropriate choirefplaint)
- 4. Transferring to a EMS Communicator, stateftblewing:

OK, Sir/Ma'am I am sending an ambulance now. I am also transferring you to my partner who will give you more directions...

Once the EMS Communicator answers state:
